To these things we/I agree:

**To honour God in those things I do and by the way I live.**

In doing so within this community I will agree to:

Commit to some daily spiritual practice (prayer, scripture reading, saying grace, etc.)

Share ideas about the community and this journey when we gather, and record some of this

\* Commit to a monthly gathering

\* Limiting my alcohol consumption in and out of the house

\* Asking for, and getting, permission from the community before having house guests

\* Neither cohabit in the house nor have intimate relations in the house when I am in a relationship with another person

\* Pay Rundle Church \$500 on the first day of the month, on time, preferably by cheque – due even if I am away

Pay 1/5 of utility and internet costs

Not have a common television

Use the Biblical model for addressing conflict, of going to the person first with my concern, bringing another person with me if necessary, and if the issue cannot be resolved using the outside resources of Rundle Church

Sign up and complete my chore list for common areas in the house

Ensure that there will not be more than 2 cars in the parking area, including guests

Participate in the life of Rundle Church on occasion

Commit to 1 hour/week or 4 hours/month of community service and be accountable for this

Notify others if I am away overnight and when I am in or out of the house (fire/emergency)
